Alex and I spoke on Friday and I explained that our office would like to terminate the submitted "Pen and Ink" change. The follow on question was that of the forecast submittal. Please see below my comments:

- 1. It is ICE's understanding that the "Pen and Ink Update" will be terminated. Assuming this is true, is there a need to submit a revised or alternate "Pen and Ink Update" product? As you are likely aware, OCF is starting a master plan project soon which should include the additional justification needed to reflect the airport's long-term development needs. Case will be terminated in OE/AAA.
- 2. To expedite the EA process and to provide justification for the future development, can a forecast be submitted in advance of a master plan working paper? The rationale behind this question is that the inventory of existing conditions has little to no bearing on the forecasts so the MP consultant could get started on this effort immediately. Once reviewed and approved by the FAA, these forecasts could be incorporated into both the EA and into the master plan projects. Yes.... We can accept a forecast prior to the MPU. We briefly touched on the EA forecast and the discussion was on that an EA forecast is typically focused on the project vs the 20 yr development plan. Ultimately, the forecast should be used to prepare a development plan that meets the 20 year forecast demand.
