Airport License

Flying Ten Airport is licensed as a public use airport in the County of Alachua with an airport reference point of latitude 29° 37' 8.100"N and longitude 82° 30' 31.600" for the period commencing 8/1/2026 to 7/31/2027 in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 330, Florida Statutes (F.S.).

When inspected on 4/9/2026, this airport did not meet state airport standards of safety for aeronautical use but the Department has determined pursuant to Chapter 330 F.S., that an exception is justified by unusual circumstances or is in the interest of public convenience and does not endanger the public health, safety, or welfare. Safe air traffic patterns have been developed for this and other licensed airports in the vicinity. This license is revocable if unsafe conditions develop or for other reasons stated in Chapter 330, F.S. or the rules and regulations adopted thereunder. This license shall in no way be interpreted as a warranty by the Department of Transportation of the continuing safety of the airport beyond the inspection date.
